DC's Report:

Happy New Year to all MPPC Members, I sincerely hope 2020 is a year full of positivity, optimism, success and opportunities for you and your family.

Our first rally for 2020 is scheduled for Sunday February 2, starting at 8am. Details are now on TeamApp so please RSVP as early as you can so we can be well prepared. The rally in March this year will be run a little differently given that it falls on the same day as the JB Tooradin HT's which is a State Qualifying event and can be recorded as a rally attendance for all riders who participate. All MPPC riders who are graded for HT's are encouraged to take the opportunity to enter the competition as all entry fees will be reimbursed by MPPC in lieu of coaching fees. A small rally will be held at our grounds for all Pink Group riders and riders not graded for Horse Trials, therefore not competing at JB Tooradin HT's.

A big focus this year at MPPC is to have as many riders as possible working towards a certificate and will be taken into consideration if you would like to be graded in 2020. We will run theory classes at most rallies to assist all riders to complete as much as possible of the work required during the rally. The certificate syllabus has all been updated and I must say it looks so much more relevant to today's Pony Club. If you have not yet completed any PC Certificates, D Certificate is the first compulsory part of the syllabus, regardless of your age. Any riders who have started the old C Certificate book can choose to either keep working through that book only if they are confident of being assessed by October 2020, if not then swap over to the new book – the upside is there is very little writing of answers in the new book, but if you do swap, you will need to start the new book from scratch.

The other big change with the certificates is D-Star is now compulsory once D Certificate is completed, and before C Certificate can be commenced. During the conversion phase this year to have all riders on the new syllabus by end of 2020, any riders who have completed D Certificate and

are over the age of 11 are advised to start working on their C Certificate and will not have to complete the D-Star Certificate.

Pink Group Riders can start the E Certificate book at any time, this is a very basic learning tool appropriate to riders who are on Lead line.

E, D & D-Star are all assessed at rallies. C, C-Star, K, B & A Certificates are all assessed by accredited assessors, either at testing days or the C-Star/K work groups set up by SMZ.

All Certificate books are now to be purchased by the rider at My Pony Club and will be posted out to you directly. Please browse to:

Log in or set up your password – follow directions, if you need assistance please ask – you basically need your PC number which is on your card, your email address is most likely set up under your parents if you need to retrieve or reset a password. Go to Store and browse through as everything is in alphabetical order so you simply need to find the certificate book relevant to you – C Certificate Book is under C and currently on page 5 for example. Purchase using your own delivery address and it will be sent directly to you. Books are \$25 + postage.

Uniform:

Riders please note **SUMMER** uniform is to be worn at the rally

It is important for riders to be in the correct gear at rallies. Winter uniform is the white shirt, brown tie, red woollen jumper, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and pony club badge. Summer Uniform is red polo top, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and badge. If unmounted pony club uniform is still required however dark jodhpurs are acceptable. Clean riding boots and pony club top must be worn. Jumping vests are recommended at MPPC for jumping lessons.



Pony Club Top Tips!

- Riders must sign in the morning with their pony club books
- Please stay for lunchtime or end of rally meeting as important information is shared during it
- Ensure your horse has access to fresh water and hay throughout the day
- - Riders must be accompanied by an adult whilst at Pony Club
 - Horses must not be tied to floats that are not attached to cars
 - Summer uniform is to be worn during daylight savings time and Winter uniform when it is not daylight savings
