DC's Report:

Hello Members,

Short & sweet report this month, it's great to be holding our July rally this Sunday at Tooradin, given we had to cancel June rally due to Covid Lock-Down measures imposed by the government. Fingers crossed we can hold our rallies as planned for the remainder of 2021.

Our Tooradin rally is always a great day out on the XC course, even though it is the middle of winter and our grounds are pretty soggy, Tooradin is very sandy, so the ground stays relatively dry. Please make sure you dress for the weather as it is forecast to be a little wet and cold.

August Rally is going to be our Dressage Rally which was planned for June, so the morning will comprise of dressage lessons focussing on components of dressage tests, and the afternoon will be riding your chosen dressage test in front of a judge and receiving valuable feedback. This is a great chance for those riders considering moving up a grade to give it a go and see where they need to improve, and it is a fabulous opportunity for those planning to compete in our Winter Dressage Competition the following weekend, to practice a test beforehand. Games/Flat/Musical Riders – for those of you new to the club, we are looking for riders interested in these fun & exciting activities, with a very good chance of representing our club at Zone, State and even National level. Games are an amazing way for riders to increase their basic riding skills doing something different which both riders and ponies find exhilarating. It is not about being the fastest and out of control, there is so much skill required to be a great games partnership. Flat riding is basically dressage in teams of 2 and 4 horses working in unison, again, lots of fun and building upon basic skill levels, and musical is dressage to music (in a nutshell). I will post up on FB as well, but if you are interested, please let me know so we can start working these into rallies for those riders keen to participate.

Pony Club Certificates – these are very important for all riders to be working through the certificates which are based our general horse care, riding & horse handling skills and safety. Uniform:

Riders please note WINTER uniform is to be worn at the rally

It is important for riders to be in the correct gear at rallies. Winter uniform is the white shirt, brown tie, red woollen jumper, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and pony club badge.

Summer Uniform is red polo top, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and badge.

If unmounted pony club uniform is still required however dark jodhpurs are acceptable. Clean riding boots and pony club top must be worn.

Jumping vests are recommended at MPPC for jumping lessons.



Pony Club Top Tips!

- \Rightarrow Riders must sign in the morning of a rally with their pony club book
- ⇒ Please stay for the lunchtime or end of rally meeting as important information is shared during it
- \Rightarrow Ensure your horse has access to fresh water and hay throughout the day
- \implies Riders must be accompanied by an adult whilst at Pony Club
- \Rightarrow Horses must not be tied to floats that are not attached to cars
- ⇒ Summer uniform is to be worn during daylight savings time and Winter uniform when it is not daylight savings
