# Mornington Peninsula & Langwarrin Pony Club Combine for the June Rally!





See you all at the LPC grounds this month. (Cozy Valley Rd, Langwarrin)

### **DC's Report:**

Hi everyone, welcome to our June rally!

We are very excited to join with Langwarrin Pony Club to hold a joint rally. We hope that you will all make some new friends and have fun exposing your ponies to new grounds. The main reason for holding this rally with LPC is that our dressage arenas at our club grounds are currently being fixed up. We are smudging the arenas to level them out a bit more, as we have some low points along the fence lines. Then, we are adding top soil. Once the grass grows back, we will be adding a bit of sand to the top to give them some stability. This means that they will be out of action all winter. Please, if you are using the grounds in the meantime, do not ride on the dressage arena area. As in previous years, our July rally will be our cross country rally held at Tooradin Estate – so this rally will be offsite too. We believe the LPC will be joining us for this rally too. More details to come on that over the coming month.

Last month our riders were very successful competing at the zone flat and games qualifier and we have both flat and games teams who have qualified to compete at states. The state competition will be held later in June, and we wish all our riders the best of luck! A huge thankyou to Kate Duignan and all the helpers involved who managed to get the teams together and organize training. A reminder that if you are over the age of 14 and you have been a member of pony club for 2 years, you must have your C certificate in order to compete at state level – so keep working away at your certificate books! We are planning to focus more on our certificate work over the rest of the year so we can get all our riders up to date with their certificates after the covid disruptions of the past few years.

Just a quick note re: grading at rallies. If you would like to be graded at a rally, it would be very helpful if you could give me the heads up before the rally – just send me an email or a text so that I can make sure I plan my day accordingly. As I have to be pretty hands on with Sienna at the moment, I may not be in the clubrooms in the morning when you sign in. The grading request forms are available from the clubrooms when you sign in or can be downloaded from our website and filled in prior to rally day.

Finally, a couple of important notes about our rally on Sunday. The canteen at LPC works on a pre-order basis. If you would like to order lunch on the day, please head to the canteen in the morning and place your order. I believe they are accepting orders from 8.30 until 10.30am. Please park in the gravel car park, or up on the grass hill past the clubrooms near the yards. If you are rostered on for SJ setup/packup or canteen helper, please be on time. Gear check is at 9am in front of the club rooms and there will be a D / D\* certificate lesson in the morning at 8.30am. If you are working on either of those certificates, please be at the LPC clubrooms at 8.30am – make sure you bring your certificate book with you! I have put a list of D / D\* riders later on in the newsletter.

### **Uniform:**

Riders please note **WINTER** uniform is to be worn at the rally

It is important for riders to be in the correct gear at rallies. Winter uniform is the white shirt, brown tie, red woollen jumper, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and pony club badge. Summer Uniform is red polo top, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and badge.

**If unmounted pony club uniform is still required** however dark jodhpurs are acceptable. Clean riding boots and pony club top must be worn.

Jumping vests are recommended at MPPC for jumping lessons.



### Pony Club Top Tips!

- $\Rightarrow$  Riders must sign in the morning of a rally with their pony club book
- ⇒ Please stay for the lunchtime or end of rally meeting as important information is shared during it
- $\Rightarrow$  Ensure your horse has access to fresh water and hay throughout the day
- $\Rightarrow$  Riders must be accompanied by an adult whilst at Pony Club
- $\Rightarrow$  Horses must not be tied to floats that are not attached to cars
- ⇒ Summer uniform is to be worn during daylight savings time and Winter uniform when it is not daylight savings
