Happy Birthday to the Horses!



DC's Report:

Hi everyone, welcome to our August rally and happy birthday to all the horses for August 1st! Don't forget to come to our lunchtime meeting – we will have cake and carrots to celebrate!

This rally we are focusing on certificate work. We are lucky to have Kathleen Kindler, the PCV coaching director, here this rally for groundwork lessons. Groundwork is now a significant focus of the certificates and is a great way to build a bond with your horse. For all groundwork lessons, riders must be in full pony club uniform with their riding boots, helmet, and gloves (if you have gloves). All riders working towards their E, D or D* certificate should bring their horse to the groundwork lesson in a halter and lead rope. Riders working towards C certificate or above should bring their horse in a bridle and should have a dressage whip with them for the groundwork lesson.

If you have completed your certificate theory book and feel you are ready to be assessed for your certificate, please let me know so we can organize it. Otherwise, we will be chipping away at the certificate assessments progressively, starting at this rally. Please don't forget to bring your certificate theory book as you will need it this rally.

A reminder to please stay off the flat grass arena as the remediation work has been completed and we need it to stabilize and dry up before we can use it.

Don't forget that gear check is at 8.45 am sharp – please be on time so that we can get the most out of our first lesson. Also, a reminder that gear check points go towards the end of year awards. So don't forget to make sure your gear and pony are clean and that you are in full pony club uniform.

Finally, and most importantly, as you are all aware, all members and parents/grandparents/friends etc. who attend 2 or more rallies each year are required to register as a club supporter (this is free to do) and upload their working with children check. New child safe laws were introduced on July 1 and it is now a law that we need to comply with. We have compiled a list of those who are still missing their WWCC and we will have an iPad at rally on Sunday so that we can assist those who are yet to upload theirs. Unfortunately, anyone that still does not have a WWCC uploaded by our September rally will not be able to attend. So please, if you need any assistance uploading your WWCC, please let us know. And please don't forget to bring your WWCC to rally as you need to upload a photo of it to your Just Go profile.



Uniform:

Riders please note WINTER uniform is to be worn at the rally

It is important for riders to be in the correct gear at rallies. Winter uniform is the white shirt, brown tie, red woollen jumper, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and pony club badge. Summer Uniform is red polo top, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and badge.

If unmounted pony club uniform is still required however dark jodhpurs are acceptable. Clean riding boots and pony club top must be worn.

Jumping vests are recommended at MPPC for jumping lessons.



Pony Club Top Tips!

- × Riders must sign in the morning of a rally with their pony club book
- × Please stay for the lunchtime or end of rally meeting as important information is shared during it
- X Ensure your horse has access to fresh water and hay throughout the day
- X Riders must be accompanied by an adult whilst at Pony Club
- X Horses must not be tied to floats that are not attached to cars
- × Summer uniform is to be worn during daylight savings time and Winter uniform when it is not daylight savings
