Please read the conditions of entry below before entering.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions. 1. Entering the event constitutes your acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and your acceptance of these rules.

2.Entry fee is per entry. Scratchings prior to closing date may incur a \$10 admin fee. No refunds after closing date unless a valid vet or medical certificate can be provided.

3. Before Riding <u>- ALL OPEN RIDERS must complete and submit a Liability Declaration form</u> - available on the day. A \$15 Day Participant Fee is also payable in addition to the entry fee UNLESS proof of current financial membership of PCV, EV/EA, AHS, SHCA, AERA, HRCAV, an Interstate Pony Club or can provide proof of Personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. If you are required to pay the \$15 Day Participant Fee, you must also complete and submit a Day Participant Waiver form.

4. Before Riding - ALL PCV RIDERS must present their 2021 and 2022 membership cards to the event office for inspection along with proof of 2023 membership to PCV, receipt etc.

5. Gear Check - all riders must present for gear check prior to warming up.

6. No horses under 4 years, no stallions, colts or rigs.

7. All riders must wear "Standards Approved" complying Helmets. Spot checks may occur, and incorrect helmet will incur elimination. Complying helmets are AS/NZS 3838 (AU), ASTMF 1163 (USA), PAS 015 (UK), VG1 (Europe), EN 1384 (Europe) only up to and including 2015, (if made in 2016, is not acceptable unless it also complies with VG1).

8. All riders under 18 years must have a parent or allocated guardian on the grounds with them at all times.

9. Ground Rules:

- No lunging permitted
- Due to the environmental sensitivity of the grounds, all feed, hay and manure must be removed and taken with you at the end of the event. Feed bags for manure will can be provided.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
