All competitors will compete as individuals

Pony club grade 5 horse trials riders can enter a team or be allocated into a team

• This event will be scored individually, with the best 3 individual scores in each team contributing to the overall team score

A rider can be eligible for all three events but will only ride each phase once

PRIZES:

- PCV G5 Team HT: Each member of the winning team receives perpetual trophy & rug
- Horse Trials: Rug for 1st, sashes for 1st to 6th place
- <u>Combined Training:</u> Saddle Blanket for 1st, sashes for 1st to 3rd place
- Super Cross: Saddle Blanket for 1st, sashes for 1st to 3rd

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of the following conditions;

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

2. Before Riding - ALL Open Sections Competitors must complete and submit a Liability Declaration form available on the day. A \$15 Participation Fee is also payable in addition to the entry fee UNLESS proof of current financial membership of PCV, EV/EA, AHS, SHCA, AERA, HRCAV, an interstate Pony Club or can provide proof of Personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. If you are required to pay the \$15.00 Day Participation Fee, you must also complete and submit a Day Participation Waiver form.

3. Before Riding - All PCV Sections Competitors must present their 2021, 2022 and 2023 Grading Cards to office for inspection

4. Gear check for ALL competitors is required 20 minutes before each phase.

5. All Competitors must wear "Standards Approved" complying Helmets. Complying Helmets are: AS/NZS 3838 (AU), ASTMF1163 (USA), PAS015 (UK), VGI (EUROPE), EN1384 (EUROPE) only up to and incl. 2015 (if made in 2016 not acceptable unless also complies with VGI) Spot checks of helmets will occur and incorrect helmets will incur elimination.

6. The use of armbands on cross country is highly recommended.

7. ... back protectors must be worn for cross country.

8. **Competitor numbers** - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers and supply body numbers which must be **worn for all phases.**

9. All Pony Club competitors must be graded by their DC for the grade they have entered.10. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any section or competition; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

11. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of Bylaws multiple horse rules.

12. Horses must be at least age four; no stallions, colts or rigs.

13. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.

14. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.

15. No Lunging permitted on the grounds

16. Riders under 8 years old are not permitted to compete in Horse Trials or Super Cross.

17. Each competitor must supply one volunteer / cross country judge for this competition. Failure to do so will result in elimination. A sign-up link will be provided a week before the event with the welcome letter and times.

18. All refunds are subject to a \$10 administration fee. There shall be no refunds after 11th of February unless notified prior to ride time to office@eventsecretary.com.au and a valid veterinary or doctor's medical certificate is provided within 7 days notification of scratching.

19. For cross country height, width, spread rules refer to PCV HT rule C10.3 Cross Country

20. For the super cross rules refer to PCV HT rules E4 Super Cross

21. Neither the organising committee of this competition, nor PCV, accepts any

responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, Competitors, ground spectators or any other person or property.
