CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Entry is conditional upon acceptance of the following conditions:

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
2. Entry fee is \$82.00 for Pony Club sections and \$82.00 for unofficial sections for two tests, \$62 for a single test. 6A entry fee is \$35. Please note there will be no refunds after closing date being Thursday 26th of January 2022` without valid veterinary certificate supplied within 7 days of notification. \$20.00 admin fee applies for all refunds.
3. **Before Riding – ALL unofficial EA competitors** must complete and submit a **Liability Declaration Form** (available on the day). A \$15 **Participation Fee** is also payable in additional to the entry fee UNLESS proof of current financial membership of PCV, EV/EA, AHS, AHSA, AERA, HRCav, an interstate Pony Club or can provide proof of Personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. If you are required to pay the \$15 **Day Participation Fee**, you must also complete and submit a **Day Participation Waiver** form (at the bottom of the Liability Declaration form).
4. **Before Riding – All PCV Competitors** must present their 2021/22/23 Grading Cards to the office for inspection and proof of current PCV membership for 2023.
5. **Gear Check** for **ALL Competitors** is required 20 minutes before their first dressage test.
6. Gear check will be using “**Pure Dressage**” Gear check Rules.
7. **All competitors** must wear “**Standards Approved**” **complying Helmets**. Complying Helmets are: AS/NZS 3838 (AU). ASTM F1163 (USA), PAS105 (UK), VGI (EUROPE), only up to and incl. 2015 (if made in 2016 not acceptable unless also complies with VGI). **Spot Checks of helmets** will occur and **incorrect helmets will incur elimination**.
8. All Pony Club dressage tests taken from ‘PCV Dressage Tests’, effective Feb 2022 – available from the PCV website.
9. All Unofficial EA dressage test taken from the 2023 Equestrian Australia tests – found on the EA website
10. **Test calling** is permitted for Pony Club and unofficial EA Tests.
11. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide or combine any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
12. All Pony Club Competitors must be graded by their DC for the dressage grade they have entered.
13. Competitors may ride more than one horse subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of By-Laws Multiple Horse Rule 34.8.
14. A horse or pony, if ridden by one or more competitor, may compete in NO more than 4 dressage tests.
15. **Pony Club and Unofficial EA riders need to supply own numbers.** (Can be bridle or saddle pad numbers). On both sides of the horse.
16. Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
17. No stallions, colts or rigs. No horses or ponies under 4 years of age. **LUNGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
18. Dogs are permitted but **MUST BE ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES.**
19. Times will be emailed to all competitors by the Sunday night prior to the event and will be posted on the Mornington Peninsula Pony Club Facebook page.
20. Neither the organising committee of this competition, nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, competitors, ground spectators or any other person or property.
